

### 2030 Project Conference Subsidy Criteria:

- Be between the ages of 22 and 39 and Jewish
- The conference must be geared towards young adults, have a young adult track or be relevant to working with young adults in terms of the content of the programs
- The conference must be Jewish (organized by a Jewish organization or have a Jewish sponsoring organization)
- A person cannot request more than one subsidy (even in another fiscal year)
- The subsidy cannot exceed 80% of the total cost of the conference (including travel expenses) (exceptions can be made for serious financial hardship)
- Costs paid or reimbursed include only: conference registration fee, hotel, travel (flight, rental car, gas or train etc.)
- Non-reimbursable costs include: meals outside the conference, alcohol, mileage
- Ideal candidates will be young adults who are engaged in the Jewish community in a lay or professional capacity or who are interested in becoming more involved upon returning
- Applicants will be required to fill out an online application form and answer all questions as well as an in person or phone conversation with a Federation young adult staff person
- After returning from the conference the participant will:
  - o meet with a Federation young adult staff person for an exit interview
  - o participate in the young adult Jewish community in some capacity
  - o write a one page report summarizing what they gained from their experience and how it can benefit connecting young Jews in San Diego to Jewish experiences/community
  - o submit 2 photos from the conference
- The conference fee can be paid by Federation in advance with other expenses reimbursed upon return
- If the applicant cannot afford to cover the travel costs in advance and wait for reimbursement then they can be reimbursed before the conference
- To be eligible to receive the subsidy applicant must currently reside in San Diego County
